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

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TERMS & CONDITIONS

 - e. Encourage all students interested in E&I activities, with an added focus on women and other underprivileged classes,
- 4. Faculties, staff & students shall be encouraged to do courses on Innovation, Entrepreneurship management and venture development.
- 5. Students shall be encouraged to develop entrepreneurial mindset through experiential learning by exposing them in cognitive skills training (e.g. design thinking, critical thinking, etc.), by inviting first-generation local entrepreneurs or experts to address young minds, by conducting idea and innovation competitions, hackathons, workshops, booteamps, seminars, conferences, exhibitions, mentoring by academic and industry personnel, throwing real-life challenges, awards and recognition etc.

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- For strengthening the innovation funnel of the institute, access to financing may be opened for the potential entrepreneurs. Networking events may be organized to create a platform for the budding entrepreneurs to meet investors and pitch their ideas.
- In the beginning of every academic session, institute should conduct an induction program 7. about the importance of E&I so that freshly inducted students made aware about the entrepreneurial agenda of the institute and available support systems. Curriculum for the entrepreneurship education should be continuously updated based on entrepreneurship research outcomes. This should also include case studies on failures.
- Stakeholder engagement should be given prime importance in the entrepreneurial agenda of 8. the institute. Institutes should find potential partners, micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs), social enterprises, schools, alumni, professional bodies and entrepreneurs to support entrepreneurship and co-design the programs.
- Mechanisms should be devised by the institutions to ensure maximum exploitation of 9. entrepreneurial opportunities with industrial and commercial collaborators.
- Single Point of Contact (SPOC) mechanism should be created in the institute for the students, faculty, collaborators, partners and other stakeholders to ensure access to information regarding Innovation & Entrepreneurship.
